CLEAN-UP WEEK



The Town Council of Centreville-Wareham-Trinity wishes to advise you that the spring clean-up period will be as follows:

**ALL clean-up material MUST BE OUT by end of day on
Monday, June 1**

Maintenance Men will **NOT** be returning to the area to collect additional debris.

Debris must be sorted in separate piles or it will **NOT** be picked up

Clean-up Material will be picked up between

Tuesday, June 2nd to Friday, June 5th

Tuesday, June 8th to Friday, June 12th

Reminder: Anything put out after June 2nd will **NOT** be picked up

Please NOTE:

- There will be **NO** pick up of construction & demolition materials (i.e. wood, gyproc, etc).
- There will be **NO** pick up of grass, leaves or alders.
- Cardboard must be tied, taped or placed inside a box.
- Glass, including windows must be put in a separate box and clearly marked.
- Garbage must be sorted. For example, separate in different piles: (a) all metals, (b) all hazardous waste (paint cans, etc), (c) cardboard, (d) electronics, etc.
- Paint cans must be empty or lid properly sealed.

Where garbage bags are needed - Use only **CLEAR** bags and **BLUE** bags. ****NO BLACK OR SOLID COLOURED BAGS - IT MUST BE PUT INTO CLEAR / BLUE BAGS. ****

REMINDER: DO NOT FLUSH RAGS DOWN DRAINS OR TOILETS AS THIS CAUSES DAMAGE TO OUR SEWER LINES.

Effective May 11, 2020, the province is designated at Alert Level 4 of the NL Life with COVID-19 plan. Essential, core, and business continuity services are on-going; residents can call **678-2840**

- Town facilities remain closed;

Curbside garbage and recycling collection on-going as per the 2020 Garbage Collection Schedule and CNWM has delayed the enforcement of curbside collection, (i.e.. Wooden boxes) until SEPTEMBER 2020.

- Public Council Meetings on regular schedule (first and third Tuesday of the month) via tele-conference.
- Playgrounds, dog parks, courts, and fields are closed;
- Bulk garbage collection remains suspended; and
- All Town events, festivals and gatherings are cancelled for Summer 2020.
